

Learning from home in Term 2 will include teacher scaffolding and more detailed modelling and instruction through comprehensive lesson plans. This will help make the 'At Home Learning' experience more family friendly. For many lessons, teachers will share explicit teaching videos or notes to help you understand the steps of each lesson. There is then an opportunity to practise these skills/concepts independently. These videos and resources will be uploaded onto Seesaw. The timing that is specified is a guide. Students may require more or less time to complete tasks.



Essential Task

Essential Tasks are important and are required to be completed.



Optional Task

Optional Tasks are not compulsory but are encouraged to be completed if possible.



This symbol means the lesson requires the student to practise the learning or skill from the previous day's lesson.



Upload work to SeeSaw

This symbol means that your teacher has requested you to upload a photo of your work to Seesaw or submit a Seesaw activity for feedback



Record your Response

This symbol means that your teacher has requested you to upload your audio/video/or note file

All resources that you will need are available to access on your child's Seesaw account to complete the following lessons:

- **Explicit Teaching -** these lessons will include a lesson plan to follow and a video/audio file with explicit teaching and lesson instructions.
- ★ Practise previous day's skill/concept these lessons will include a lesson plan to follow and are designed to practise the previous day's learning.
- ★ **Revision** these lessons are designed to consolidate your child's learning for the week.

Chilli Challenge

The Chilli Challenge is like a menu (imagine a Thai takeaway menu) where students choose their level of challenge for the lessons provided, moving up or down if it is not the appropriate fit. We suggest students start at the 'spicy' level and move up and down depending on their abilities. This gives students ownership over their learning and allows them to use their Challenge Learning Power to work at the right level of challenge for them.

These symbols represent the level of challenge that your child can choose from.







<u>Please note:</u> Not every activity will have the Chilli Challenge option. Students are required to complete these activities as they are.

English

The English session will run for approximately one hour each day. It will include a combination of reading, spelling, writing, comprehension and speaking and listening tasks and activities. This is an essential component of At Home Learning. You may be required to upload a work sample for your teacher to view and give you feedback on.

Please check Seesaw each morning to find the English lesson plans for *Reading* and *Writing* along with the activity posts for that day.

<u>Maths</u>

The maths session this week will contain different activities for each day. There may be a video provided for students to follow interactive instruction and demonstration. Students may be required to complete a worksheet or respond to an activity on Seesaw.

Please check Seesaw each morning to find the Maths lesson plan and activity post for that day.

STEAM: STEAM lessons will align with the Science or History topics.
