High Standards of Uniform

Thank you to all our families for your ongoing support to ensure that our students are always dressed in full school uniform. The wearing of school uniform instils a sense of pride, creates a unified community and improves school spirit. I have received some comments from local shop owners and community members of how 'stylish' the students look in their newly designed uniforms.

Attendance

Going to school everyday provides the opportunity for best school results and positive school experiences. It is imperative students arrive to school on time as it allows children to be part of the daily school routine and not miss out on important information presented at the beginning of the lesson.

Late Arrivals/Early Pickup

There are strict guidelines we have to follow to ensure that we have an accurate record of Student Attendance. Late arrivals must be recorded as a partial absence and are referred on to the Department of Education. Parents must accompany their child to the Elizabeth St gate, students are not permitted to present to the gate/office without an adult to 'sign' them in and explain absence. We encourage parents to collect students before or after our break times, as it is difficult and time consuming to locate children on the playground. Our break times are Recess: 10.30am-11am and Lunch: 12.30pm-1.30pm.

- Applications for Year 7 entry to selective high schools in 2022 will be accepted from Tuesday 13 October 2020 to Monday 16 November 2020.
- Parents must apply online at https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7
- All applicants are required to sit the Selective High School Placement Test to be held on Thursday 11 March 2021.
