From Maker Space Room

"During STEAM this term, Stage 1 explored the exciting use and ability of the 'Makey Makey' micro-controller. The Makey Makey is a controller that works through opening and closing circuits, just like any other button. Instead of the circuit being closed underneath your keyboard, the circuit is closed through the conductive objects you connect with alligator clips like your hand, food or some tinfoil.

Students collaboratively designed their own version of a 'Whack a mole' controller, similar to the arcade game. Students used creative craft skills to create and build the controller. After testing, improving and connecting their designs to the computer using the alligator clips, we were able to have our own Paddington Makerspace Arcade
