

Before School Arrival Time

A reminder to all families that no child should be on the school grounds prior to 8:40am unless they are attending an organised activity such as PSSA training, chess or attending POOSC.

We have noticed an increasing number of children arriving or being dropped at school very early. Playground supervision does not begin until 8:40am so for safety reasons students are not to be on site. POOSC provides a wonderful before school care service should you need to drop your child earlier that 8:40am.

Attendance Matters

Everyday Counts Attendance at school is a routine that must be encouraged. It is important that children attend school every day. It is a requirement that any child that has three consecutive days or more from school is required to provide a medical certificate on their return to school. If a certificate is not provided, our office staff will contact you. Attendance is reviewed at the Learning Support Meetings and students whose attendance is a concern are identified and parents are contacted. A day away from school here or there doesn't seem like much but absences add up.

If your child misses as little as one day each week, they will miss 40 days of school and 8 weeks of learning in just one year. Over an entire school journey, this adds up to 2.5 years of lost learning. Our expected target is for our students to attend school more than 95% of the time. If your child is absent, please register the absence and the reason for the absence using the School Bytes Parent Portal.

Sun Safety and Hats

Very important message from Alison – Skin Cancer/Melanoma is very real for me as most of you know. Whilst I am doing really well at the moment, the battle which started in 2019, got bad in 2023, but has improved dramatically in 2024 is something I will battle with forever, as I didn't do the right thing in the sun!

I strongly encourage all parents to ensure your child has their school hat with them every day. If every child is wearing their hat while in the playground then my job of skin cancer awareness is done and I am proud that I shared my story to educate the community that being in the sun is ok with the correct protection.

All students at Paddington PS are required to wear their hat whenever they are outside. If they don't have their hat they will be asked to play in the shade. We also have sunscreen available in playground duty bags and the office.

School hats are bucket hats for students in Kindergarten to Year 5 and a cap for Year 6. If your child does not have a school hat, they are available for sale from the office or the uniform shop.

Reminder School Fees are to be paid by Thursday 31 October 2024.


Uniform Shop


