#### **Athletics Carnival**

#### **Attendance**

Student attendance is reviewed regularly. Our expected target is for all our students to attend school more than 95% of the time. If your child is absent from school, you will receive a text message at 11.30am please reply to this message with the reason for your child's absence. #### **Everyday Counts**

Going to school every day gives your child the opportunity to experience success with learning, to build positive relationships with other students and to engage in social experiences. It is important that students arrive at school on time as it allows children to be part of the daily school routines, not miss out on important information presented at the beginning of the lesson and settle into the school routine a lot better.

The Department of Education encourages all families to take their vacations during the school breaks. The school does not approve leave for holiday purposes unless it is under exceptional circumstances. If there are exceptional circumstances, then parents are required to complete an application for extended leave – travel, if the leave is for 5 or more school days. The form can be obtained by emailing the school or requesting a hard copy from the school office. The form must be submitted no later than 2 weeks prior to travel. Please note that travel documentation also needs to be attached to the application form upon submission.



#### **Debating**

On Thursday May 22, our two Paddo debating teams travelled to Kensington Public School to compete in Round 1 of the Premier's Debating Challenge.

The first debate featured Xanthe, George, Dylan and Oliver. They were assigned the negative role, debating 'That Years 5 and 6 kids should learn a new language each term'. They put forward strong arguments and rebuttals, thinking well on their feet. The independent adjudicator declared them the winning team!
